Transit Services for Race

<u>SFMTA</u> will provide service to and from the downtown area. Market Street Subway will open at 6am and will provide extra service on the N Judah and S Shuttle Lines. Please note that only <u>select stations</u> will be open early, the rest will open at regular weekend times.
